Activities sheet 7: Ninjas always have good luck


Let's do some fun activities related to the chapter "Ninjas always have good luck" from the book "Nico, the little detective". The first activity should be done before reading the chapter of the book.

Activity 1: Help Nico solve his case

- Ask your family and friends what they think about whether luck can be improved and what actions they would take to do so.


Activity 4: The challenge of Nico's questions
